

Accessibility of the content of the Classification of Occupations via API

The Classification of Occupations is available and downloadable (in JSON format) via machine-tomachine interface at <u>https://estat.stat.ee/codelists/codelist/AK2008ap</u>.

The classification is consistent and elements have a start and end date. This means that elements are not deleted or changed: if necessary, an end date, or in the case of a new element, a start date is fixed.

Always check the expired and started elements so as not to use an expired element as an employee's occupation. It is advisable that the user is notified of such changes in the classification by the software and that the respective notifications requiring action by the user are displayed on the screen.

Reporting 3.0. Wages and labour force taxonomy

Statistics Estonia has developed a set of classifications (taxonomy) in cooperation with Eesti Pank and the Tax and Customs Board. In case this taxonomy is used in the payroll software (module), data can be transmitted via machine-to-machine interface straight from the software and reporting in eSTAT is no longer necessary.
